Prospective students who are retired military, in the military reserves, or on active military duty are eligible for a 25% tuition grant when the proper verification and discount form are submitted at the time of initial enrollment. All NSU alumni may apply for a 20% tuition grant. Talk to a doctoral enrollment counselor for additional tuition grants available.

Eligible degree programs include the master of science in leadership (M.S.), master of science in education (M.S.), educational specialist (Ed.S.), doctoral (Ed.D.) degrees, and the certificate of advanced graduate studies (CAGS) in education. Courses are offered online or on-site.
