- ** **FSC 8000 – Summer Conference on Global Leadership, Learning and Research.** Students will also be required to attend this conference during the first summer in which they enroll in the doctoral program. For additional information, please go to: www.fischlerschool.nova.edu/summer.
- *** **Prerequisite Information - Students must complete:**
 - EDD 9200 prior EDD 9300
 - EDD 9300 prior EDD 9100 and EDD 9100S
 - EDD 9300 prior ARC 8913, ARC 8914, ARC 8915, ARC 8916 or ARC 8919
 - ARC 8913 prior ARC 8917
 - ARC 8912 or ARC 8916 prior ARC 8920
 - ARC 8912 prior ARC 8918
 - Core Courses (EDD 9200, 9300 and 9100) are offered in a blended, on-site, cluster-based format. For those students desiring only an online delivery format, the core courses may also be taken online. **EDD 9100S is only offered online.**

- **** **Minor courses (Optional)** – Students must take all five minor courses (15 credits) in order for the minor to be recognized and listed on the transcript.
- **** **Concentration courses (optional)** – Student can have a dual concentration.
 - o Students following any of these two options will graduate with 66+ credit hours depending on the minor or concentration chosen.
- **Elective courses (Optional)** – Students can take any concentration or minor course to fulfill this requirement.
- ***** **Applied Dissertation Services** begin at the 25th month (beginning of 3rd year) from the initial term of enrollment irrespective of registration records. At this time, candidates will automatically be placed in **ADS 8090 - Applied Dissertation Services I**, per term, for a period of up to one year (3 terms). ADS 8090 has a \$100.00 tuition charge + services fees (subject to change). **Candidates who do not complete the program within this time period must register for ADS 8091 - Applied Dissertation Services II.**
- **ADS 8091 - Applied Dissertation Services II** begins at the 37th month (beginning of 4th year) from the initial term of enrollment irrespective of registration records. At this time, candidates will be responsible for registering for ADS 8091- Applied Dissertation Services II, per term and every term thereafter after dissertation is officially approved by the Applied Research Center. ADS 8091 has a \$2,200.00 tuition charge + services fees (subject to change).
