

## STANDARD V

### Field Experiences

All candidates (Letter Of Eligibility) are required to participate in a series of field experiences. All Nova Southeastern University participants are required to accumulate a minimum of 198 field experience hours. Each curricular area (appendix) must reflect at least three field experience hours per each earned academic credit. All field experience hours must relate to course offering and will be monitored by an NSU faculty member who has expertise in that given academic area. At the conclusion of each three credits the candidate will submit a log or other supporting evidence to the faculty member for his/her review.

Examples of field experiences are:

In-service presentations

Conference presentations

Observations (school board meetings, finance committee meetings, negotiation sessions, superintendent council meetings, etc.)

Articles for publication

“How to” tapes or lessons

Evaluation tools developed

Workshop presentations

An overall reflection is required of each participant at the conclusion of his field experiences. The participant now has an opportunity to synthesize and analyze all that he/she experienced and will be reviewed and assessed by the university faculty member.
